An MS assistantship is available at West Virginia University Division of Forestry and Natural Resources. The graduate research assistant will serve as the WV Forest Stewardship Program Outreach and Education Coordinator. This coordinator is responsible for producing quarterly newsletters, forestry information sheets, and field workshops. In addition, the coordinator serves as the secretary of the WV FSP Committee. Thesis research will focus on the treatment of invasive plant species or nontimber forest products.

Experience with forestry, wildlife, or nature-based tourism is desirable, but not required. A valid driver's license and the ability to hike and work in rough terrain under adverse weather conditions are required. The MS stipend is \$15,000 along with a tuition waiver. Expected start date is January 2010.
